Lithium-Polymer Cell Wins “Technology Showcase Award” in Singapore

Once again, Varta's LFP lithium-polymer cell has won an award. The paper-thin LFP 7 and LFP 25 cells came top in the “Technology Showcase Award” at GlobalTRONICS 2000 in Singapore. Yet another success for the Ellwangen battery experts! In the spring, readers of “Elektronik” also chose the cells as Product of the Year 1999.

GlobalTRONICS in Singapore is the third largest exhibition of electronic components in the world, after Productronica in Germany and the Nepcon West trade fair in the USA. It is the most important electronics trade fair in Asia. The exhibition was attended by over 850 exhibitors from 31 countries, including many well-known international companies.

A “Technology Showcase Award” was given at this trade fair for new developments in production, accessories and technology.
